**DOLAZAK NA KAMPUS:**

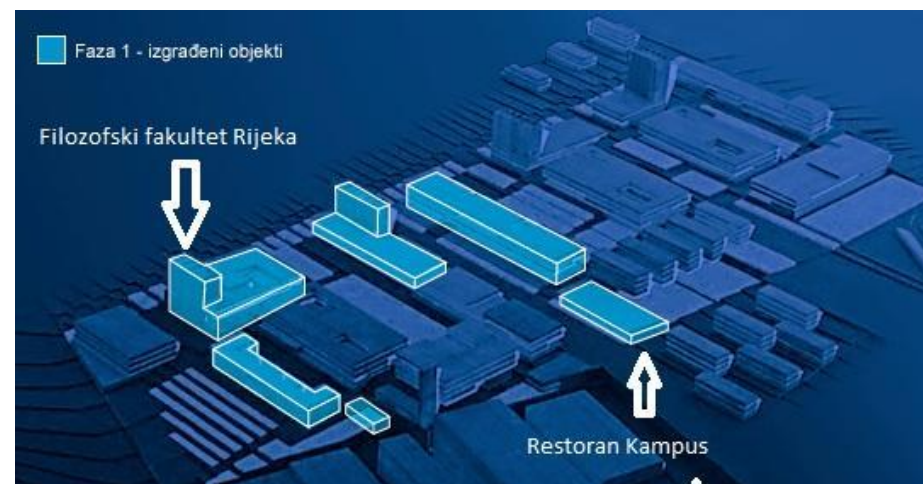

#### **TRAVELLING TO THE CAMPUS TRSAT:**

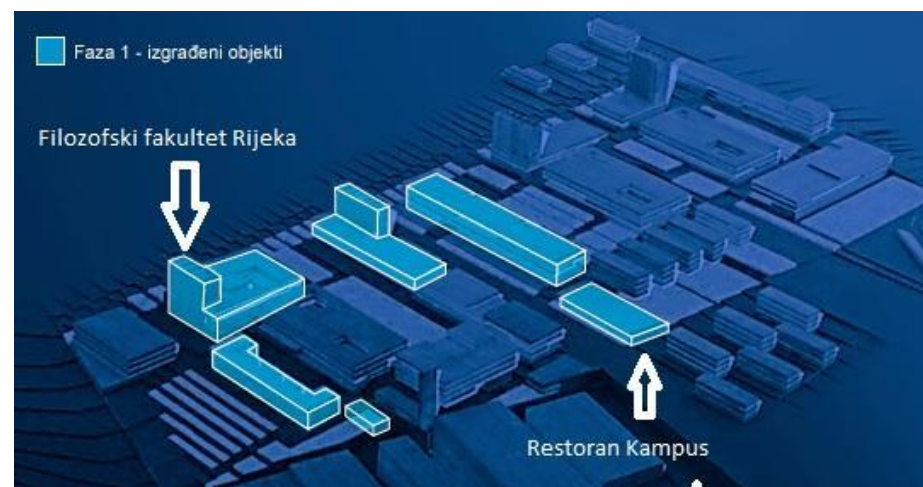
